About Frantic Music Project:

Founded in 2022 by Al and Mary "Frantic" Knight, co-owners of Frantic Frets Music, the organization began supporting musicians and the music community in 2020. The pandemic hit many industries hard, and musicians were no exception. Venues closed and live music events were cancelled. Most working musicians earn their living through live performances, thus losing their sole income source.

In March of 2020 we learned of a local artist who was diagnosed with Stage-IV cancer and had to cancel all their performances for the foreseeable future. Through the support of 21 musicians and dozens of artists, a 3-day virtual fundraising concert and auction was held, helping to raise tens of thousands of dollars for the artist.

Bringing the community together is extremely important to us, and in 2020, we also began hosting outdoor concerts and open mic programs through our business, Frantic Frets Music & Antiques. We have engaged thousands of people - musicians and those who love live music, through our events. People were so grateful for these socially distanced events to play or listen to live music. Today, they continue to enjoy our grassroots, parking lot house concerts.

To date, through catastrophic illness fundraisers for a number of Delaware musicians, instrument donations, repairs and services for struggling musicians, we have raised and distributed close to \$200,000 since 2020. We have organized dozens of concerts and nearly 200 open mic programs for new, up and coming, or returning musicians who benefit through education, encouragement, and honing their musical skills.

About Mary and Al Knight:

Mary has a background in business and nonprofit management, logistics, event planning, and marketing. She has planned small, intimate events to large town and county festivals with up to 10,000 attendees.

Both Al and Mary are both musicians and deeply involved in the music community in Southern Delaware. They have owned and operated Frantic Frets since 2018 and are excited to be able to bring an event like this to Delaware. Through events, performances, and their business, they have a large network that is very supportive of all their efforts.
